HIRING AGREEMENT – Appendix 1: Sale or Supply of Alcohol

1. The sale or supply of alcohol at West Chilton Village Hall requires the written
2. approval of the Trustees.
3. Applications must be submitted to the Booking Secretary using a printed copy of this
4. form at least **one month** in advance.
5. There is no charge for obtaining this approval.

Breaches of the Licensing Act 2003 can result in severe penalties, including imprisonment and/or fines of up to £10,000.

The licensing objectives are to promote the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of children from harm.

Every applicant must undertake all of the following:

- The applicant will be present at all times during the sale, supply, or consumption of alcohol.
- Alcohol will not be sold or supplied to any person under the age of 18.
- Alcohol will not be sold or supplied to any person for the consumption of another person under the age of 18, except as stated below.
- A young person aged 16 or 17 may consume beer, cider, or wine with a meal, provided it is purchased by and consumed under the supervision of a person aged 18 or over.
- Alcohol must not be consumed outside the premises (for example, it may not be taken outside to drink while smoking).
- Alcohol will not be sold or supplied to any person who is, or appears to be, drunk.
- A full price list must be displayed showing the price of each drink.
- **Drinks may be consumed until 23:00, but service at the bar must stop no later than 22:30.**
- On New Year's Eve, drinks may be served at the bar until midnight and consumed until 00:30 on New Year's Day.

The following persons have the right to enter the premises and close the bar:

- Members of the Committee of West Chilton Village Hall
- Police officers
- Trading Standards officers
- Environmental Health officers
- Fire Service, Building Control, and Council Licensing officers
- HM Customs and Excise officers

I accept the above terms and conditions and will assume full responsibility for the operation of the bar and for compliance with the Licensing Act 2003.
